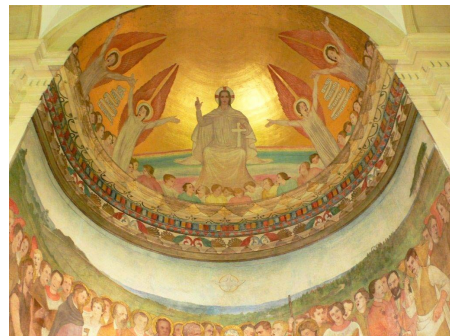
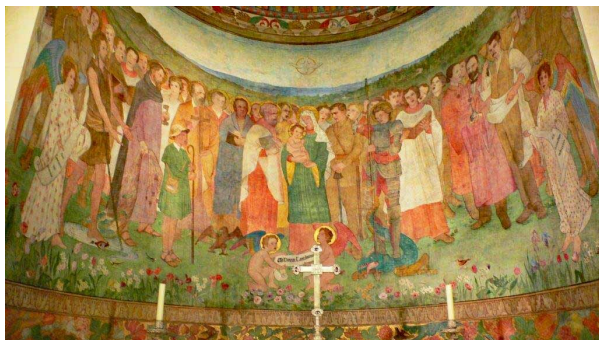

All Saints' Church, Bransgore, Christchurch BH23 8DG www.avontyrrellestate.com/Church

Built for Lord Manners to commemorate the death of his daughter from cholera and designed with Arts & Crafts principles in mind – to be lit by candles. Inside is an important mural painted by Phoebe Traquair. It fills the whole semi-circular apse from floor to ceiling and depicts famous characters such as William Blake and Louis Pasteur.

The fine murals in this beautiful 12th Century Church are the largest single work of art in the East of England. Created by artist Phoebe Anna Traquair in the early 1900's and restored in 1996, they cover all four walls within the church, are truly spectacular and full of surprises.

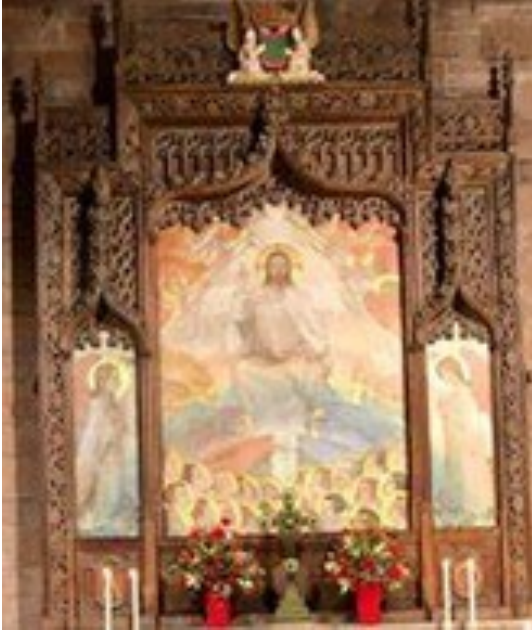
